

LINE UP!

(6 minutes)

WHY: To get your team communicating to one another and up and moving

HOW:

Equipment:

- N/A

How to complete:

- Split your tribe into 2 equal teams.
- Explain that this will be a competition between Team A & Team B.
- You will call out a category (e.g. height order) and the aim is to make one straight line as a team from shortest to tallest
- Once the team has successfully lined themselves up they need to call out your tribal name in one loud unified voice.
- The team that successfully lines up first wins the round. – repeat a couple of times
- Possible categories are:
 - First Name (A-Z) – use this one first as a great way to learn each other's names
 - Shoe Size (smallest to biggest)
 - Place of Birth (suburb or city or state if unsure) (A-Z)
 - Number of siblings (least to most)
 - Month you were both (January- December) Year at school you are in (youngest to oldest)
