

TRIBAL FEUD

This Game Show Challenge will be tribe versus tribe. Tribes will compete in rounds and the tribes will have 3 strikes per round/question. Strikes are given when the tribe to 'buzz in' first answers the question incorrectly.

On each strike, the other tribe will have the chance to answer the question.

The first tribe to 'buzz' and gives a correct answer on the first questions will begin. This tribe can continue to guess two more answers (3 in total) before game play will move to the other tribe or until they score a strike. After each answer attempt, the person at the front of the line will move to the back to allow shared game play.

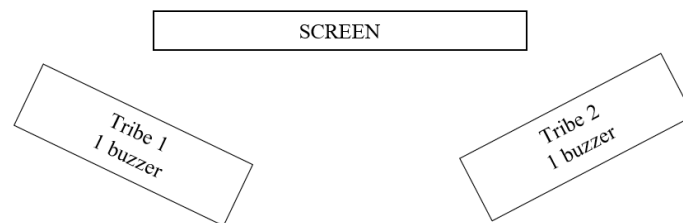
At 3 strikes for the question, the host will move on to the next question.

Each team will earn the points corresponding to the answers they have guessed on the board.

Location: Main Hall

Resources: Buzzers x2, PowerPoint equipment and USB with presentation, 1x Tribal Feud Answer Sheet, 1x Points Sheet.

Points: Each tribe will be awarded the number next to their answer on the board.



How to explain the game:

Welcome to Tribal Feud! In a moment, a question will appear on the board. The first Tribe to 'buzz' and correctly guesses an answer to the questions will receive the points next to that answer on the board.

That Tribe will then be invited to guess another answer. Your tribe will get up to three guesses before game play moves to the other tribe.

If a Tribe guesses an incorrect answer, they will score a 'strike/X' and game play will go to the other Tribe.

When the question has reached 3 strikes, the host will move on to the next question.

Points scored for each Tribe are the number of votes for the answers they guess correctly, which will show up on the board. These will be recorded on the point sheet and revealed at the end of the Game Show Challenge.
